

Method 1: Pre-Commercial Procurement (PCP)


- NCBR determines the research challenge and orders technology,
- Several contractors compete with their R&I solutions to advance it to the next stage,
- The results of the projects are technologies and demonstrators developed,
- Green Deal compliant programmes: Hydrogen Storage, Electric VAN, Biogas Plant, Heating Plant of the Future

Method 2: Great Challenges

- NCBR determines the research challenge (e.g. mini wind turbine),
- The result of the projects are prototypes of solutions ready for further development.








NATIONAL CONTACT POINT






POLISH SCIENCE AND BUSINESS VOICE IN BRUSSELS- NCBR Office
